Terms and Conditions ('T&Cs')

Day rates and half date rates will apply to most work, related to specific activities (e.g. herd health reviews, investigations, training, group meetings, producer pool work, courses, qualification assessment). See Table 1. If unspecified, a generic consultancy fee will apply based on £125/hour excluding travel within 1 hour from BH21 and excluding delays due to traffic.

Additional costs include mileage at 45ppm, accommodation (single room, basic facilities), use of specialist equipment, subsistence (meals) and other travel (e.g. flights, train, parking). VAT is chargeable for work in the UK. If a day is split between 2 or more independent clients then the travel plus additional costs will be attributed fairly.

Times of work will be confirmed prior to the meeting. No charges will apply to postponement provided reasonable notice (7 days) and no costs are incurred. A fair allocation of cost will be agreed if there is cancellation without reasonable notice.

The client is protected by professional confidentiality. No data or photographs will not be shared with a 3rd party without consent from the owner of the data/place. Data will be stored in accordance with GDPR.

Veterinary surgeons responsible for the day-to-day care of the animals (the prescribing vet) will be informed of visits beforehand (whenever possible) and will be briefed following the visit unless you request otherwise.

A concise email summarising findings and actions will follow, if possible within 7 days of a meeting.

Advice and training are based on the best available information and published evidence at the time. Concepts and available information often change or evolve, so please seek further professional advice should you become aware of such changes. Technical updates may be shared by email (see end).

All activities are covered by Professional Indemnity and Public Liability cover, in the event of an accident that is attributable to negligence. All work will be carried out by Bos International Ltd trading as Herd Health Consultancy unless otherwise specified. All relevant professional qualifications are available on request.
